#### **NSS ANNUAL REPORT 2017-2018**

The **NSS ORIENTATION program** was held on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2017 with 200 NSS Volunteers. Dr. G. Bhaskaran (NSS Co-coordinator, University of Madras) was the chief guest for the event. Dr. Bhaskaran addressed the students and he explained the students about volunteerism and various roles and responsibilities of NSS volunteers.

Swachta Pakhwara (Cleanliness Campaign): From 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017 to 15<sup>th</sup> August 2017

The **Ministry of Human Resource Development and Ministry of Youth Affairs**, initiated all colleges to conduct **Swachta Pakhwara**, the cleanliness campaign for spreading the message of cleanliness not only among the students but also in the surrounding area.

A Seminar was conducted on Swachta Pakhwara with 100 NSS volunteers. Eminent speaker, Mr. M.B. Nirmal (Founder of Exnora International) Environment service organization, was invited. On the Second day, NSS Unit of the college initiated a cleaning campaign at College campus with 50 NSS Volunteers. On the third day, NSS Unit of the College organized a five hour cleaning campaign in adopted slum at Kannagi Nagar with 50 NSS Volunteers. On the fourth day, NSS team of the college conducted a street play in adopted slum in Ezhil Nagar, Street play conveys a message to people in the slum about the water stagnation and the diseases which caused by water stagnation, followed by rally on the fifth day, along with the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, Chennai Corporation, with 60 NSS volunteers.
