The Guest Speaker Dr. Sivaganeshan explained about Herpetology, branch of Zoology concerned with the study of amphibians and reptiles. He explained about different types of snakes, interesting facts about snakes and spoke about 300 species of snakes. He also briefed the immediate Medical treatment for the snake bite. He said that further research is required to ratify claims that some herbs are effective against snake venom. By keeping your surroundings neat and clean we can protect us from snakes or any other insects.

A STUDY TOUR TO NANMANGALAM FOREST

A study tour to Nanmangalam forest as a part of the curriculum was conducted to create exposure among the faculty and students was initiated by Enviro Club of our college in association with Chennai Snake Park Trust on 28.09.2019. The expected outcome includes providing ample study opportunity and situation for the faculty members and students to learn and get acquainted with the process of field work and understanding the environment around us. 60 members comprising 28 faculty members and 32 students from various departments were actively participated. The programme commenced with Dr.Siva Ganesan, explaining about the details of the 1 day trip. The entire group was divided into two group one group consisting of 30 members was lead by Dr.Siva Ganesan Deputy Director cum Environmental Education Officer and training, Chennai snake Park trust and another 30 members lead by Dr.S.R.Ganseh –Deputy commission –Research. They started to explain about the forest and its tropical evergreen condition prevailing in it.
