STUDENTS ADMISSION

The college reopened on the 18th June for the 2nd and 3rd years and on 27th June for the first years. To meet the increasing demand for Commerce education, one more section was added to the Commerce stream. The University of Madras has sanctioned 10 additional seats in BA English course. Our admission status continues to show an upward trend. During the academic year 2014 – 2015 a total of 635 students were admitted at the UG and PG level. The College now functions with a strength of 1657 students with 7 under graduate and 2 Post Graduate degree courses.

LIBRARY

The Library is the heartbeat of an Institution. A library advisory committee headed by Director and Secretary and Principal was initiated in June 2014 and library committee members from staff and students nominated. Frequent Library users among staff and students were identified and awarded prizes in the ceremony. A Book Fair was held on the 3rd of September. SALIS (Society for the Advancement of Library and Information Science) along with PuthiaThalaimurai Channel Organized Mega rally “VasippomNesippom” on Nov 15,2014 to promote reading habits among youngsters. Patrician College library Volunteers and students from various departments participated the Grand Rally.

New Delany Library was inaugurated on Nov 24,2014.Blessings and Prayers were led by Dr.Fr. PLACEMENT

All the final year and second year of UG students were given class-wise career orientation to scale up the placement opportunities across sectors and verticals. Students were trained in Resume preparation and Group Discussion. Placement campaign for 2014-15 commenced with TCS. Mr. Muralimohan, HR, who is an alumnae of Patrician College was part of the recruitment team. One hundred students participated and twenty students received the offer letters. Placement cell has facilitated part-time jobs and seasonal jobs during the Deepawali season.
