Quality initiatives of IQAC for Academic year 2018-2019:

ERP training for New Recruits: To familiarize the new recruits with the modules of the ERP system, hands-on training for the new recruits was given by Mrs. Sangeetha, Coordinator-ERP, from 1/6/2018/ to 9/6/2018 in the computer lab.

FDP on “ NAAC- The New Framework : On 14th June 2018, FDP on “ NAAC- The New Framework” was organized for the faculty. Mr. B.S. Ponmudiraj, Deputy Adviser, NAAC, Bangalore, was the resource person. The revised assessment framework was explained to the faculty in details. The qualitative and quantitative metrics and the documents to be uploaded was oriented. The data validation process and the importance of students satisfaction survey was also emphasized on. Mr. Ponmudiraj insisted on the importance of documentation and timely updating of the website.
