Admission Procedure

1. Click Apply button
2. Click Registration button
3. Enter your Name, DOB, Mobile Number and email id
4. You will receive a confirmation message giving your user id and password
5. Use this id and password for all future communications
6. Fill the application form and attach the relevant documents (Copy of Aadhar card, community certificate, 10/11th /12th and TC optional)/for PG programme attach UG mark statements and Provisional /Degree Certificate.
7. Click the submit button
8. After submission of application if you are eligible you will receive a message regarding the date and time for an interview with the Head of the Department (HOD).
9. UG - If selected, you will have to pay an initial payment of the college fees immediately to reserve your seat. The details of the fees structure will be intimated by the Head of the Department (HOD).
- 10.UG - Within 3 days of publication of the Board results you will meet the concerned Head of the Department (HOD) in college along with your Parent /Guardian and submit the necessary documents and pay the balance amount of first installment college fees.
- 11.PG - First installment fees has to be paid after the interview with the Head of the Department (HOD). Date of commencement of college will be intimated later.
- 12.Your admission will be confirmed after submission of documents and payment of fees.
- 13.The Second installment of UG/PG fees should be paid by Second week of December
- 14.The banker will retain one copy of the fee challan, one copy should be submitted to the concerned Head of the Department (HOD) and the candidate will retain the student's copy for future reference.
