On 28th August 2015, Women Cell organized a seminar on the Reproductive Health Problems among girls and women. **Dr. Kalaivani**, Neuro-Gynecologist and Obstetrics Specialist of Apollo medical centre, Adyar Branch addressed on Reproductive Health and the importance of understanding it for today's youth. About 200 girl students from all departments participated in the talk show which was very informative and useful for their life. The core idea is to promote of reproductive health, voluntary and safe sexual and reproductive choices for students including decisions on family size and timing of marriage. Sound reproductive health is integral to the vision that every child is wanted, every birth is safe, every young person is free from HIV, and every girl and woman is treated with dignity. Implicit in this vision is the idea that men and women will be able to exercise their rights to information on and access to safe, affordable and acceptable methods of fertility regulation as well as quality health care services. The latter will enable women to experience safe pregnancy and childbirth, across the world. Poor women, especially in developing countries, suffer disproportionately from unintended pregnancies, maternal death and disability, sexually transmitted infections including HIV, gender based violence and other problems related to their reproductive system and sexual behavior.

Reproductive health concerns cut across many socio-economic aspects. Indeed, the health sector alone cannot resolve them. The seminar ended with the feedback session where students raised lot of questions regarding the women health problems and troubles faced by women in the society.
